## Care and Maintenance

The Furniture should be dusted with a soft dry cloth. A coat of natural beeswax should be applied to the wood a couple of times a year to maintain its lustre. Avoid the use of cleaning agents or spray polish as these can contain abrasive substances and over a period of these can penetrate the finish and spoil the surface.

Furniture tops may be damaged by hot plates, wet cups and objects with sharp or hard surfaces. It is recommended to use place mats.

Spilt liquid should be wiped off immediately

When lifting/carrying the beds or larger items, they should be carried by at least two people and held along the sides and/or the frame. No additional loads should be on the furniture and it must not be pulled along the floor this can weaken the joints and damage the furniture permanently.

If applicable, at least every 4 months the bolts should be checked to make sure that they are tight.

The Furniture should be placed at least 1 meter from active heat sources such as radiators and heaters. They should be used in rooms that are dry, closed and protected against the effect of atmospheric conditions including the effect of direct sunlight. Too dry or damp air may cause deformities to some parts of the furniture. Avoid placing the furniture on damp surfaces.

The stool, bench, chair seat pads and the material on the bed can be cleaned with a vacuum with a soft brush attachment. Never use cleaning agents that contain abrasive substances or solvents. The stool, chair and bench will need to be placed on a level surface to ensure stability when sitting. They are intended for indoor use only. Do not stand on them.
